# Child Behaviour & Technology:

For parents interested in the changes to media and technology and how this may impact upon their own engagement in their children's development, there is an interesting scientific study looking into children's behaviour from a technology perspective. Here is a brief summary and also an address to the full online report;

Abstract: Children, wired - for better and for worse Daphne Bavelier, 1C. Shawn Green, 2

and Matthew W. G. Dye3

Children today encounter and utilize technology constantly both at home and in school. Television, DVDs, video games, the internet, cell phones and PDAs – all now play a formative role in many children's development.

Given that the term "technology" subsumes a large variety of somewhat independent items, it may not be surprising that current research indicates causes for both optimism and for concern that depend upon the content of the technology, the context in which the technology immerses the user, and the developmental stage of the user.

### Register your cat



Happy New Year, Here's hoping your Christmas time was enjoyable and that 2018 has started well for you.

First up a wee reminder to be "sun-smart" as you enjoy the warm holiday weather. Keep out of the sun during the hours of 10 to 4 and cover up well if you can't avoid it. Enjoy the sun during the earlier and later parts of the day – remember some sun is vital to replenish our Vitamin D.

Note that Dr Kate will be away for the week of the 15 to the 19<sup>th</sup> of January. Our nurses and some locum cover will be available during this time. If you need to see Dr Kate, be in early to book a time before or after that particular week. Also keep in mind that the practice is incredibly busy over the month of January due to the number of visitors to the area, so if you can schedule your appointment for February, that is even better.

Another reminder about repeat prescriptions.Our staff taking the request require: name, contact details, name of medication, and dose, method of collection, and the name of pharmacy if to be faxed. Please ensure you have these ready when you call. Alternatively you could email your request to clinic@colville.org.nz . A repeat prescription will cost you \$10-00 and remember we require 48 hours notice. It can take some time to have these completed so best not to leave it till you have run out of medication.!

So until next time, keep safe and enjoy the summer days - the team at the Colville Health Clinic.
